Introduction:

The NEBOSH Diploma is *the* qualification for aspiring health and safety professionals, building directly on the foundation of knowledge provided by the NEBOSH National General Certificate. It is designed to provide learners with the knowledge and understanding required for undertaking a career as a health and safety professional and also provides a sound basis for progression to postgraduate study.

The qualification deliberately looks at general workplace issues so it can be applied in the many different sectors in which health and safety professionals may work. On completion of the qualification, learners will be able to:

- * Understand how health and safety legislation is applied in the workplace and how possible enforcement actions could be taken for non-compliance and how they contribute to health and safety legal actions.
- * Use different types of health and safety leadership approaches and be able to influence health and safety issues at all levels.
- * Influence organisational health and safety workplace culture.
- * Proactively manage health and safety, taking account of human failures and factors.
- * Manage health and safety competence (both their own and that of their organisation).
- * Use a range of hazard identification, risk management and loss causation techniques.
- * Monitor health and safety performance.
- * Develop their role as a health and safety professional, including understanding how it links with Corporate Social Responsibility.
- * Effectively manage organisational change.
- * Manage contractors and supply chains.
- * Control a range of workplace health and wellbeing issues.
- * Control a range of workplace safety issues.

Assessment:

There will be 3 assessments for the 2021 Diplomas. The assessments will be in the following format:

- Unit ND1: assignment;
- Unit ND2: case study; and
- Unit ND3: case study.

The first assessment date is planned for 6 September 2021 with the first assessments being for Unit ND1 only. This date may be subject to change.

This attention to the finer detail of the examination ensures that most of our candidates pass first time.

Important:
